  - No longer offer \$9M Umbrella limit, highest limit \$5M: quoting excess limit of \$4M with other carriers to retain the \$9M limit MOU for Town of Vernon to match

- Classes to define: Training, Instructions, For Profit, Not for Profit, For the Good of the Club
- ON HOLD For-Profit training (outside RF&G scope) member owning a business and hosting classes through RF&G i.e. Pistol instruction, CPR for a fee

## TRAINING COMMITTEE ACTION ITEMS

- Develop curriculum and classes for in-house training not offered elsewhere
  - o i.e. Safe gun storage, how to transport a firearm, how to sight-in a firearm, how to clean a firearm
- Annual review of SOPs (Develop a Code of Conduct or Statement of Ethics)
- Review and discuss new Gun Laws to better understand the law i.e. HB7042
  - Legislative committee to consult with State Representative Tammy Nuccio and US Law Shield and plan a presentation to discuss the impact of new laws and respond to member questions
- Survey membership for wants and needs; how can training needs be met
- Develop a 'Train the Trainer' program
- Establish a program for approving trainers for advanced training
- Special Events should remain with the Third Vice President as a special event
- Training committee involvement in special events as a collaborative partner on an 'as needed' basis
- Next meeting fall of 2025 identify classes and build a training calendar of monthly offerings
- TABLED NRA instructor issues
- Is training self-funded? Develop a 2026 training budget for a Call meeting vote?
- Develop a training budget for approval by the Board; in the interim training costs will be funded through SEES
