Bill Alert: Attention Gun Owners

Last week, the Government Administration and Elections (GAE) Committee voted out [HB 5448 AN ACT CONCERNING SECURITY OF CERTAIN ELECTION WORKERS AND ELECTIONS-RELATED LOCATIONS](#). The bill will head to the Judiciary Committee this week.

Section 2 of the bill makes possession of a weapon near an elections site a Class D felony, conviction of which can result in a state prison sentence ranging from one to five years and additional fines up to \$5,000, if a person is lawfully carrying a firearm (or weapon) within 250 feet of elections locations, including drop boxes, and any area where votes are being administered or counted.

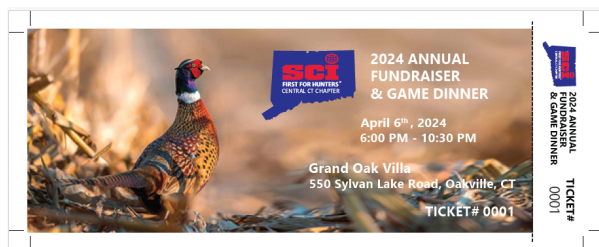
