Rockville Fish & Game Club Pond Regulations 2024

The Rockville Fish & Game Club offers two ponds for members and their guests to enjoy. Opening day for fishing the Ponds is 4/1/24 at 6:00am.

Note: Both Ponds will be closed to fishing on Wednesday May 1st through Saturday May 3rd. They will reopen on Sunday May 4th at 6:00am.

Pond Specific Rules

Lower Pond – The Lower Pond is open for all live and artificial bait including lures, spinners, and fly fishing (Single Hooks Only).

Upper Pond – The Upper Pond is restricted to artificial lures, spinners, and fly fishing (Single Hooks Only). **No Bait is allowed**.

Common Regulations for both Ponds

- 1 Each member (or person in his/her family) must have a current pond ticket to fish in the ponds.
- 2 Only one fishing rod per ticket will be allowed. The fishing rod may be used by the pond ticket holder, or spouse, or guest. The club member holding the pond ticket must be present at all times when a family member, or guest is using either of the ponds.
- 3 Fishing logs are provided at each pond. Members must sign into the fishing log whenever using the ponds whether a fish is caught or not. If fish are caught and/or taken, the correct information needs to be recorded into the fishing log. This is important as this information is used for determining how many fish are to be stocked in the ponds every year.
- 4 Fishing is open between 6:00 A.M. and dusk.
- 5 Fishing is allowed from the shore only. Keep out of the water.
- 6 Only Single Hooks are to be used (Barbless hooks are encouraged if you intend to release the fish). No Treble Hooks Allowed.
- 7 **Fish Limits**: The "Week" is Monday through Sunday for the purposes of recording your catch.
 - a. Adult Ticket Two fish per day and four fish per week.
 - b. Youth Ticket One fish per day and two fish per week.
- 8 If a fish is being released, please do it immediately to ensure its survival. Do not release any injured fish that will not survive. Record these fish as taken in the Fishing Log
- 9 Members and guests may continue fishing after they reach their daily limit but must immediately release all new fish caught.
